The Advent Journey

In one sense Advent is about waiting for the coming of the King, waiting for Jesus to come again. But Advent is also a time that resonates with journeys, each part of the Advent/Christmas story involves journeys, everyone travels, most of them geographically but some take a journey of understanding.

It always amazes me how quick the journey through Advent can seem. I often feel I have missed some aspects of preparation before reaching the end of Advent and the beginning of Christmas. I've become very conscious this year of how important it is to try and slow down at this time, to find space and time in our lives to ponder on how we are preparing the way for God to come and dwell with us, to dwell in us, by His Spirit.

In many ways Advent is a companion to Lent as a focus time that leads up to a big celebration, but Advent is only four weeks instead of six. So, I would encourage you to try and mark this journey by finding ways to stop and reflect on the way, find those moments where you can pause and cultivate a joy in your heart amidst all that is going on around us both locally and in the world. Jesus says to his disciples 'Watch and pray' and we do well to put those words into practice this Advent.

This December I am going to try to read a new book by Paula Gooder – 'The Women of the Nativity' – a companion to her excellent 'Women of Holy Week', it has short chapters and just one for each week so I hope it will be manageable for me! Other great Advent books and reflections are available. You are welcome to join in our Advent/Christmas services, and invite friends, neighbours and family to join the Advent journey too.
